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The Treehouse Club

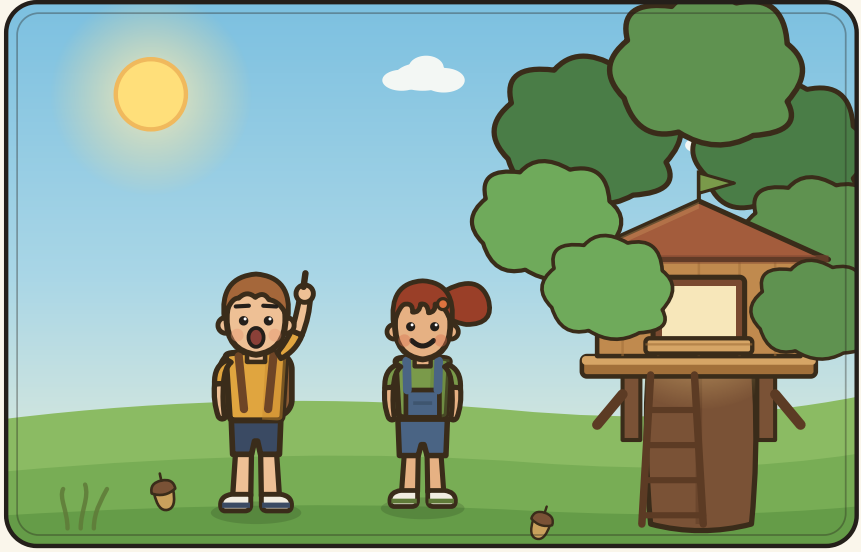

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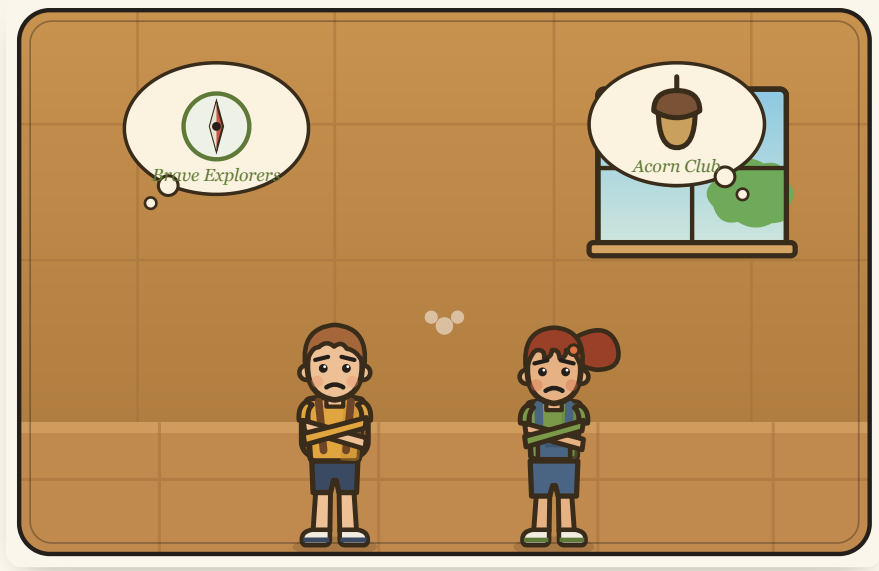
In Finn's backyard grew a big oak tree. High in its branches sat an old wooden treehouse. It had been there for a long, long time.

“Mine is better,” said Finn. “No, mine is,” said Ruby. They crossed their arms and turned their backs. Neither one would budge.



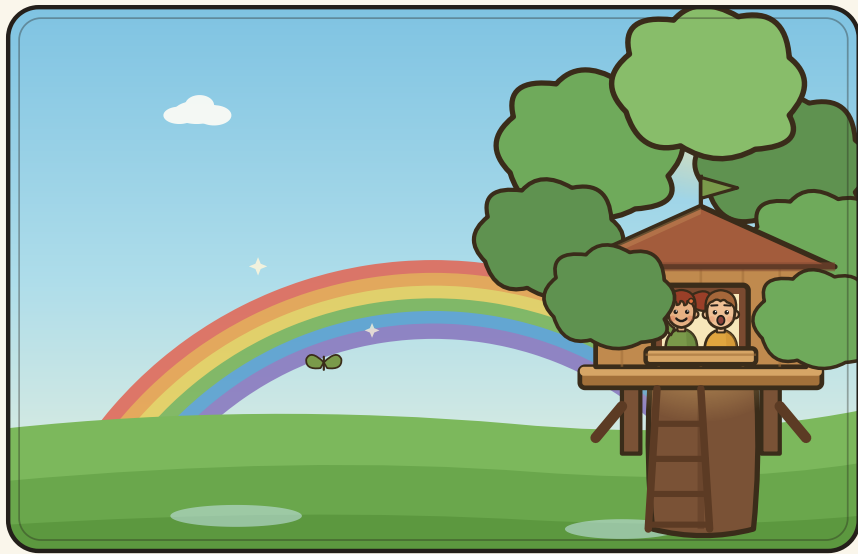
Then the sky turned dark and gray. Rain began to fall. It went pitter-patter on the treehouse roof.
